



Suggestion 4 – Develop an editorial calendar

- Identify four categories of posts to make topics easier to find. Keep content focused on your club.
- If possible, write at least three months worth of posts for each category and supplement when you have something timely to post.

Use the Facebook scheduling tool or free tools like Hootsuite to post all at once.

- Week 1 – Rotary general post
- Week 2 – Highlight a past community project
- Week 3 – Ask a question of your members so others can learn from their responses
- Week 4 – Introduce a member


Suggestion 5 – Create your own ads and tools using Canva or other tools





Create a design from a template

Work Around – Changing out a logo

- The designs provided cannot be edited directly, however in some cases you can cover the logo with a box the same color as the background and put a new logo over the top. The exact colors used in the design are available in the campaign style sheet. We recommend however, following the instructions for new designs and creating a new design for your organization using the graphics provided, but adding your own images and logos.

(will crop to a circle)

Square: 1200 x 1200
